New Resident & Family Belongings Checklist

General preparation guidance. Confirm every item against the home's admission, laundry, safety, infection-prevention, privacy and resident-property policies.

■ Label belongings Use the home's approved labelling method and include the resident's full name where permitted.	Notes:
■ Bring a practical quantity Plan around available closet and drawer space and the home's laundry schedule.	Notes:
■ Choose washable clothing Confirm arrangements before bringing delicate, special-care or dry-clean-only items.	Notes:
■ Avoid fragile details Use caution with sequins, beads, delicate lace, fragile buttons, loose decorations and heavy fleece.	Notes:
■ Photograph key belongings Keep photographs of distinctive, sentimental or higher-value belongings.	Notes:
■ Record identifying details Note brand, colour, size, unique marks and serial numbers where applicable.	Notes:
■ Review valuables policy Ask about cash, jewellery, electronics, hearing aids, dentures and other small valuables.	Notes:
■ Confirm what is supplied Ask about linens, towels, toiletries, hangers, storage and seasonal items.	Notes:
■ Identify assistive items Mark walkers, wheelchairs, cushions, chargers, glasses, hearing devices and cases.	Notes:
■ Keep records current Tell staff when belongings are added, removed, taken home, replaced, donated or discarded.	Notes:
